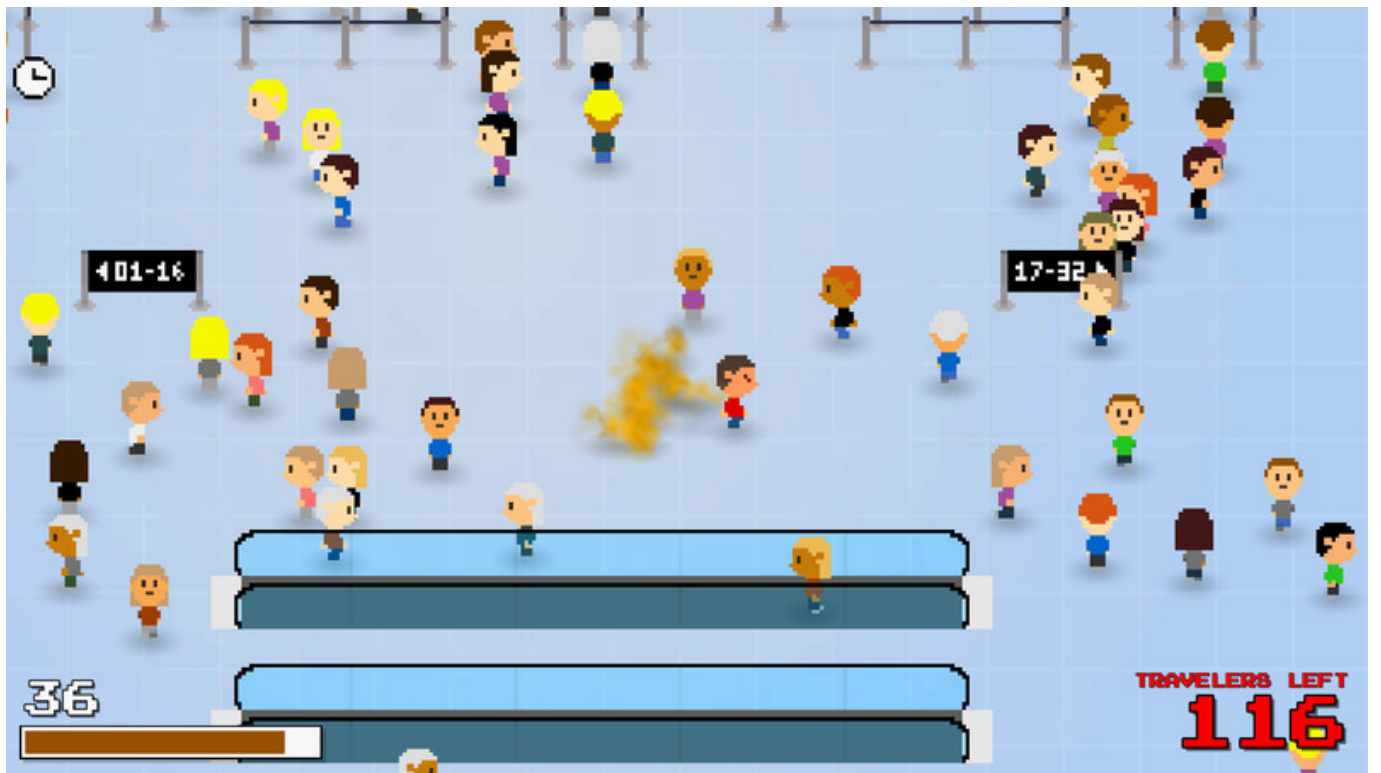

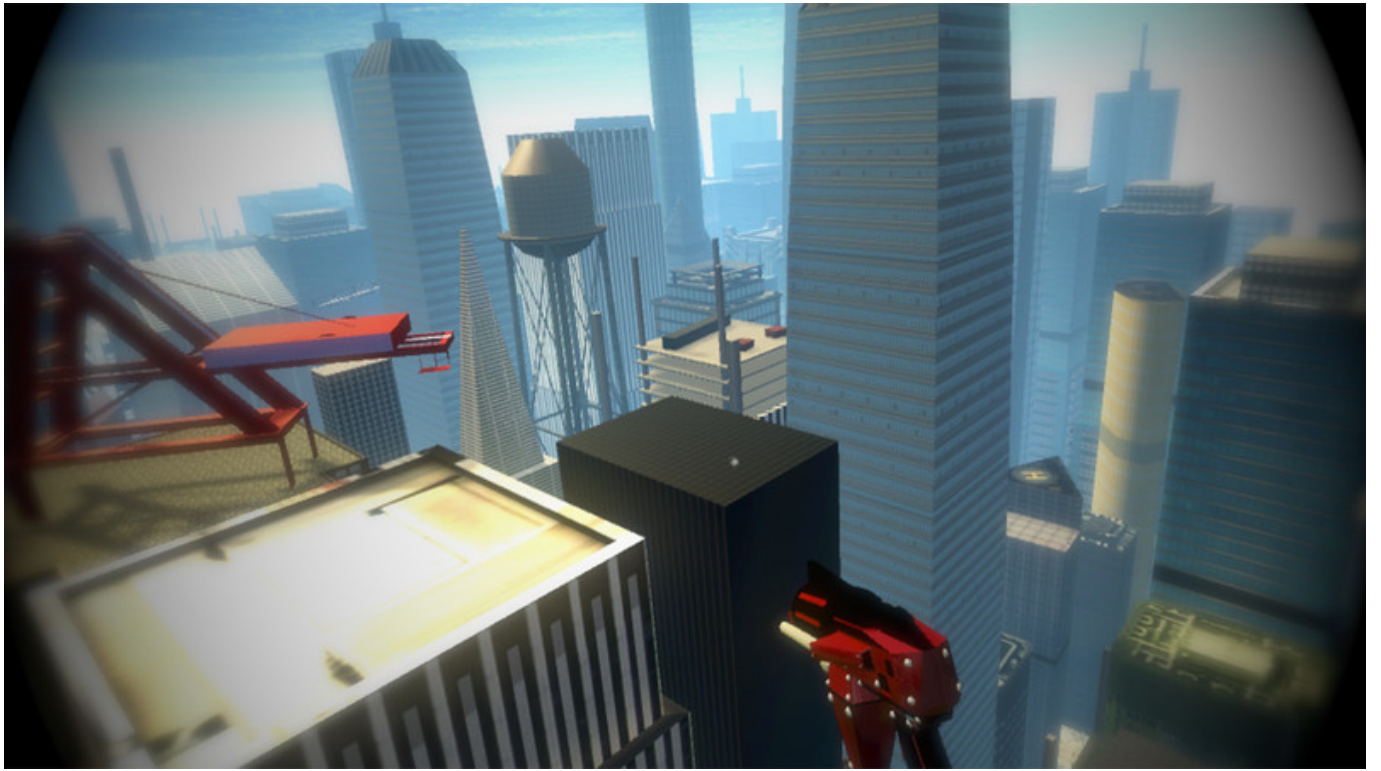

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valkyria chronicles 4 expert level skirmishes

Incredible gameplay, great co-op with your friends, and not to mention setting the graphics to "Fantastic" will blow your mind. 9/10. This is a must buy.. A groundbreaking way to immerse the player in history.

The game pummels you with a series of heart wrenching twists and turns on an emotional rollercoaster, but, to an extent, you have a feeling of agency, choice, that you would not get with a movie. I would love to see this applied to the Iran-Iraq war, the fall of the Berlin wall, Vichy France, Mao's China, Tiananmen Square, the Viet Nam and Iraq wars, the French Revolution, the Bolshevik Revolution, the Great Depression, the US Civil war, Roman occupied Judea, and so much more!

The game puts you in the role of a photographer, that seemingly neutral arbiter of truth, and yet it shows not only the events outside the frame, but just how imbued with personal feelings photography is. The game has a passable 3D world that you can navigate in line with the story, and voice actors speaking a mix of Farsi and English. The sound effects and ambient sounds are immersive. There are "Dragon's Lair" style action sequences that I loved, other mini games that I liked - such as bandaging a wound, and button mashing minigames that I felt could have been done better. The white diamonds that help you hone in on the action quickly are perfectly done. The home movies and photographs are a splendid touch.

There is some replayability in trying to explore other paths the player can take, finding all the historical points of interest, as well as achievements and cards. 1979 is true to the medium of PC games, and not just a documentary masquerading as a game; it is a game, and a good one.

This is a must play for anyone with a connection to Iran, or an interest in geopolitics and modern history. The game was even handed with the various political factions involved in the Revolution, leaving the player with an understanding of the motivations, without trying to favor any particular creed.

The game is priced at the price of a movie ticket, and about as long for the first playthrough: fair.. boring gameplay. Annoying music. good thing i got it for free. I do not think it's that nice.

Opponents' trucks are nearly indestructible so there's little fun in trying to destroy them.

Graphics are blurry.

Limited camera options.. Nice regular top-down shooter with co-op option. Absolutely recommended!. This game is a love letter to every wannabe game designer who's played Mario and completely missed what makes it such a brilliant game. The jump physics are floaty and hard to control. The camera is sticky and often forces you into leaps of faith. Platforms are arranged with no rhyme or reason, and it's often visually ambiguous where you can stand and where you can't. Enemy AI makes no sense: sometimes swarms of enemies will gleefully dive-bomb you from off screen, and other times the same enemy types will sit perfectly still, ignoring you as you shoot them. You have health, but levels are mostly made up of insta-death pits. The story mocks itself and the game's arbitrary mechanics right from the first level. Even more embarrassingly, the first thing you see in the game is the fact that two-thirds of the game's content (the second and third acts) are listed as "Coming soon!", despite the game having been released seven years ago (as I write this). It doesn't matter what price point this game is offered at, there is no enjoyment to be had here.

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If you liked HoneyPop, give this game a try. If you get the r-18 patch, this game really opens up and makes it worth playing. Great match 3 gameplay with lots of girls without any of the dating sim stuff. Simple and to the point.. First of all, these reviewers saying this is not "Reversi" but actually "Othello" I have no idea what they are talking about. I've been playing Reversi/Othello for a long time, as well as have been researching board and card games, and I have never encountered a version that didn't start with four pieces in the center, and I've always found "Reversi" and "Othello" used interchangeably. But games like this are old and acquire many rules over time. Who can really say, and does it really matter that much?

Now, as for the game itself, don't buy it unless it's on a pretty heavy sale. I waited until it fell down to about \$3, and had I paid a dime more than that I'd have been pretty upset. While functional it lacks polish. Only two varieties of pieces, no varieties of boards or backgrounds. The background music is annoying with no other options. The sound effects are grating. Seems like small stuff, but they are all things that should be present for \$10 whole wing-wangs. In 3-D mode the pieces flip over in a very satisfying way, but if you make a large capture the computer goes immediately after while your pieces are still flipping. And if you make a large capture, and the computer makes a large capture, your first pieces could be flipping back before your captured pieces are finished turning over. I find it to be incredibly annoying.

All of these seems like small complaints and they are, but to be charging \$10 I'd expect a lot more. I'd expect a lot more especially when you can just google "Reversi" or "Othello" and find a low tech flash version on a website and play for free. So save your \$10 and put it towards a real Othello/Reversi board you can buy at any Toys'R'us.. Want to take out your buried, immoral, human tendencies?

Want to relive the stress that has been building up during your time at work or school?

or

Want to turn a brain it to a fine red mist?

Want to rip someone's arm off and beat them to death with it?

Want to impale someone with their jaw from the comfort of your home?

Want to experience a Wolverine movie from a first person, interactive perspective?

Then buy GORN.
